5 REASONS WHY JESUS IS AN INEXPRESSIBLE GIFT

1. Because of how long the Gift lasts (John 1:1; Psalm 90:2)
2. Because of His nature (Exodus 3:14; Romans 8:3)
3. Because of how He gives Himself
 - Sacrificially (I Peter 2:24)
 - As a propitiation
 - As a reconciliation between us and the Father
4. Because of the grace by which He gives Himself (Romans 5:8)
5. Because of what He produces
 - Forgiveness (Psalm 103:12)
 - Justification (Romans 5:1)
 - Heirs with Christ (Romans 8:17)
