





HOW MANY COMMANDMENTS DID DAVID BREAK?

- Commandment #6 David murdered Uriah.
- Commandment #7 David committed adultery.
- Commandment # 8 David stole the purity that was within the marriage between Uriah and Bathsheba.
- Commandment #9 David lied to others about his true intentions for Uriah when he put him on the front lines of battle.
- Commandment #10 David coveted someone that God had not given to him.




GOD'S VIEW OF SEX
