

Caiaphas	Matt 26:57-68; Mark 14:53- 65; Luke 22:54	Religious	Accused Jesus of saying he would destroy the Temple and of blasphemy
Sanhedrin	Matt 27:1-2; Mark 15:1; Luke 22:66-71	Religious	Determined to have Him killed
Pilate	Matt 27:11-14; Mark 15:1-5; Luke 23:1-5; John 18:28-38	Civil	Sent Jesus to Herod
Herod	Luke 23:6-12	Civil	Mocked Jesus; not a serious trial
Pilate (again)	Matt 27:15-26; Mark 15:6-15; Luke 23:13-25; John 18:39-19:6	Civil	Traded Jesus for Barabbas; found Jesus innocent but sent Him to be crucified



Who Was Pilate?



I. Jesus is sentenced by the Jews (vs. 1-2).

II. Jesus is questioned by Pilate (vs. 11-14).
