 - b. Stops along the way Cyprus, Antioch, Cilicia, Derbe, Lystra, Phrygia, Galatia, Mythia, Bithynia, Troas, Neapolis, Philippi, Thessalonica, Berea, Athens, Corinth, Cenchrea, Ephesus, Caesarea, Antioch, and Jerusalem
 - c. 3-year journey, covering about 2,700 miles

	missionary teams: Barnabas and John Mark and then Paul and Silas, also met Timothy, Lydia,
	and Aquila and Priscilla
