
ITHESSALONIANS 1:3-4

"The man that believes will obey; failure to obey is convincing proof that there is not true faith present."



¹⁴ What good is it, my brothers, if someone says he has faith but does not have works? Can that faith save him? ¹⁵ If a brother or sister is poorly clothed and lacking in daily food, ¹⁶ and one of you says to them, "Go in peace, be warmed and filled," without giving them the things needed for the body, what good is that? ¹⁷ So also faith by itself, if it does not have works, is dead.

What Made the Church Worthy of Emulation?


More than work

"toil that results in weariness, fatigue, or extraordinary effort"

More than casual Christian activity, but suggests getting tired in service

The Word "Labor"

What Made the Church Worthy of Emulation?

Means "endurance" or "patience"

More than being optimistic, but living with complete certainty

The Word "Steadfastness"

³ For, being ignorant of the righteousness of God, and seeking to establish their own, they did not submit to God's righteousness. ⁴ For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to everyone who believes. ⁵ For Moses writes about the righteousness that is based on the law, that the person who does the commandments shall live by them.

What Made the Church Worthy of Emulation?

Means "to choose out of" or "to pick from many possibilities"

Means you select someone and not someone else

 It is God making a choice to save someone (giving what they don't deserve) and not choosing someone else (so they will get what they do deserve).

The Word "Chosen"

¹¹ though they were not yet born and had done nothing either good or bad—in order that God's purpose of election might continue, not because of works but because of him who calls—¹² she was told, "The older will serve the younger." ¹³ As it is written, "Jacob I loved, but Esau I hated."
