- Shechem raping Dinah (Gen 34)
- Reuben taking his father's concubine, Bilhah, for himself and his father
 - having a concubine to begin with (Gen 35)

Sexual Sin in Genesis – Men Against Women

Ham embarrassing his drunk and naked father
 Noah (Gen 9)

The men of Sodom wanting to have sex with

Lot's male guests – maybe angels (Gen 19)

Sexual Sin in Genesis – Men Against Men

Sarah making her servant Hagar sleep with her husband
 Abraham so she can create a surrogate womb for herself
 (Gen 16)

Leah doing the same with her servant Zilpah

Sexual Sin in Genesis – Women Against Women

- Lot's daughters getting their father drunk so they can sleep with him and conceive children (Gen 19)
- Tamar seducing Judah her father-in-law so she can get pregnant (Gen 38)
- Potiphar's wife trying to get Joseph to sleep with her (Gen 39)

KEY POINT:

We please God by <u>separating</u> ourselves from sexual sin.

How can we measure our sanctification?

By abstaining from sexual immorality.

The Put Off (vs. 3)

¹⁹ Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God? You are not your own, ²⁰ for you were bought with a price. So glorify God in your body.

I Corinthians 6:19-20

- Teens for sexual favors
- Mistresses, concubines, female sexual slaves
- Prostitutes over wives
- Sex slaves for entertainment
- Favorable sexual pleasure outside of marriage

Sexual Immorality in the Roman Empire

Let marriage be held in honor among all, and let the marriage bed be undefiled, for God will judge the sexually immoral and adulterous.

12 Sexual Prohibitions in the Bible

⁹ Or do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived: neither the sexually immoral, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor men who practice homosexuality, ¹⁰ nor thieves, nor the greedy, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor swindlers will inherit the kingdom of God.

I Corinthians 6:9-10

• "to hold back" – like abstaining from a vote

"to be away, to be distant" – how it is being used in I

Thessalonians - Matthew 14:24; 15:8; Mark 7:6

The Word "Abstain"

But put on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make no provision for the flesh, to gratify its desires. Do not enter the path of the wicked, and do not walk in the way of the evil. Avoid it; do not go on it; turn away from it and pass on.

But sexual immorality and all impurity or covetousness must not even be named among you, as is proper among saints.

Ephesians 5:3

¹⁴ But each person is tempted when he is lured and enticed by his own desire. 15 Then desire when it has conceived gives birth to sin, and sin when it is fully grown brings forth death.

James 1:14-15

1. Internal sinful desires are stirred up (vs. 14).

2. Lust is conceived (vs. 15a).

3. The lust becomes visible (vs. 15b).

4. Sin brings death (vs. 15c).

From Temptation to Sin

"Unthinkingly, without measuring, filtering, or processing, we expose our minds to that which, were we thinking, would be unthinkable. And each time – gradually, subtly, imperceptibly – we surrender just a little more mental and moral turf to anti-Christian values.
