#### **KEY POINT:**

God has not left us in <u>ignorance</u> about what to look for in the end and how to <u>live</u> as we <u>wait</u> for it.

Children, it is the last hour, and as you have heard that antichrist is coming, so now many antichrists have come.

Therefore we know that it is the last hour.

I John 2:18

- No human has the power for it, or the Jewish state or the church.
- It doesn't make sense that Satan would restrain him.
- Not a binding of him
- God is the One who restrains (vs. 6-7). Also, John 16:8-11.

 $^{7}$  And when the thousand years are ended, Satan will be released from his prison 8 and will come out to deceive the nations that are at the four corners of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them for battle; their number is like the sand of the sea. 9 And they marched up over the broad plain of the earth and surrounded the camp of the saints and the beloved city, but fire came down from heaven and consumed them, <sup>10</sup> and the devil who had deceived them was thrown into the lake of fire and sulfur where the beast and the false prophet were, and they will be tormented day and night forever and ever.

<sup>20</sup> As for what was sown on rocky ground, this is the one who hears the word and immediately receives it with joy, <sup>21</sup> yet he has no root in himself, but endures for a while, and when tribulation or persecution arises on account of the word, immediately he falls away. <sup>22</sup> As for what was sown among thorns, this is the one who hears the word, but the cares of the world and the deceitfulness of riches choke the word, and it proves unfruitful.

Riches can deceive - Matthew 13:20-22

13 ... They count it pleasure to revel in the daytime. They are blots and blemishes, reveling in their deceptions, while they feast with you. 14 They have eyes full of adultery, insatiable for sin. They entice unsteady souls. They have hearts trained in greed. Accursed children!

Lusts of the flesh can deceive – II Peter 2:13b-14

See to it that no one takes you captive by philosophy and empty deceit, according to human tradition, according to the elemental spirits of the world, and not according to Christ.

Human traditions and philosophies can deceive - Colossians 2:8

so that we may no longer be children, tossed to and fro by the waves and carried about by every wind of doctrine, by human cunning, by craftiness in deceitful schemes.

False teachers can deceive - Ephesians 4:14

But exhort one another every day, as long as it is called "today," that none of you may be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin.

Sin can deceive - Hebrews 3:13

If anyone thinks he is religious and does not bridle his tongue but deceives his heart, this person's religion is worthless.

Self-deception - James 1:26

"The Truth War is not a carnal war. It is not about territory and nations. It is not a battle for lands and cities. It is not a clan war or a personality conflict between individuals. It is not a fight for clout between religious denominations. It is not a skirmish over material possessions. It is a battle for the truth. It is about ideas. It is a fight for the mind. It is a battle against false doctrines, evil ideologies, and wrong beliefs. It is a war for truth."



 <sup>23</sup> And these three men, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, fell bound into the burning fiery furnace.


#### **Daniel 3:22-23**
