**Why Was the Old Self Crucified?**

- **After the fall** – *non posse no peccare* – “not able to not sin”
- **After salvation** – *posse non peccare* – “able not to sin”
- **In heaven** – *non posse peccare* – “not able to sin”

**A Helpful Application:**

- Where does that put us? (vs. 3-10)
  - We are united in Christ’s death and resurrection (vs. 3-5)
  - Sin is not our master any longer (vs. 6-7)
