- Psalm 119:34 "Give me understanding, that I may keep your law and observe it with my whole heart."
- Illumination happens when God works in us to help us believe and understand (John 15-16).
- Illumination not for the non-Christian

"We would be abler teachers of others, and less liable to be carried about by every wind of doctrine, if we sought to have a more intelligent understanding of the Word of God. As the Holy Spirit, the Author of the Scriptures, alone can enlighten us rightly to understand them, we should constantly ...
