


#### "O Love, That Will Not Let Me Go"




#### "O Love, That Will Not Let Me Go"

O Joy that seekest me through pain, I cannot close my heart to thee; I trace the rainbow through the rain, and feel the promise is not vain, That morn shall tearless be.








