





3 Models of Church and State

- 1. Erastianism/Constantinian The State controls The Church.
 - a. Constantine makes Christianity a state religion (A.D. 325)
 - b. The State controls The Church called Erastianism.
 - c. The State favors The Church called Constantinian
- 2. The Theocratic model The Church controls The State
- 3. The Partnership model The Church and State recognize they have different God-given roles (Matt 22:15-22)

⁷ All the nations shall serve him and his son and his grandson, until the time of his own land comes. Then many nations and great kings shall make him their slave.


