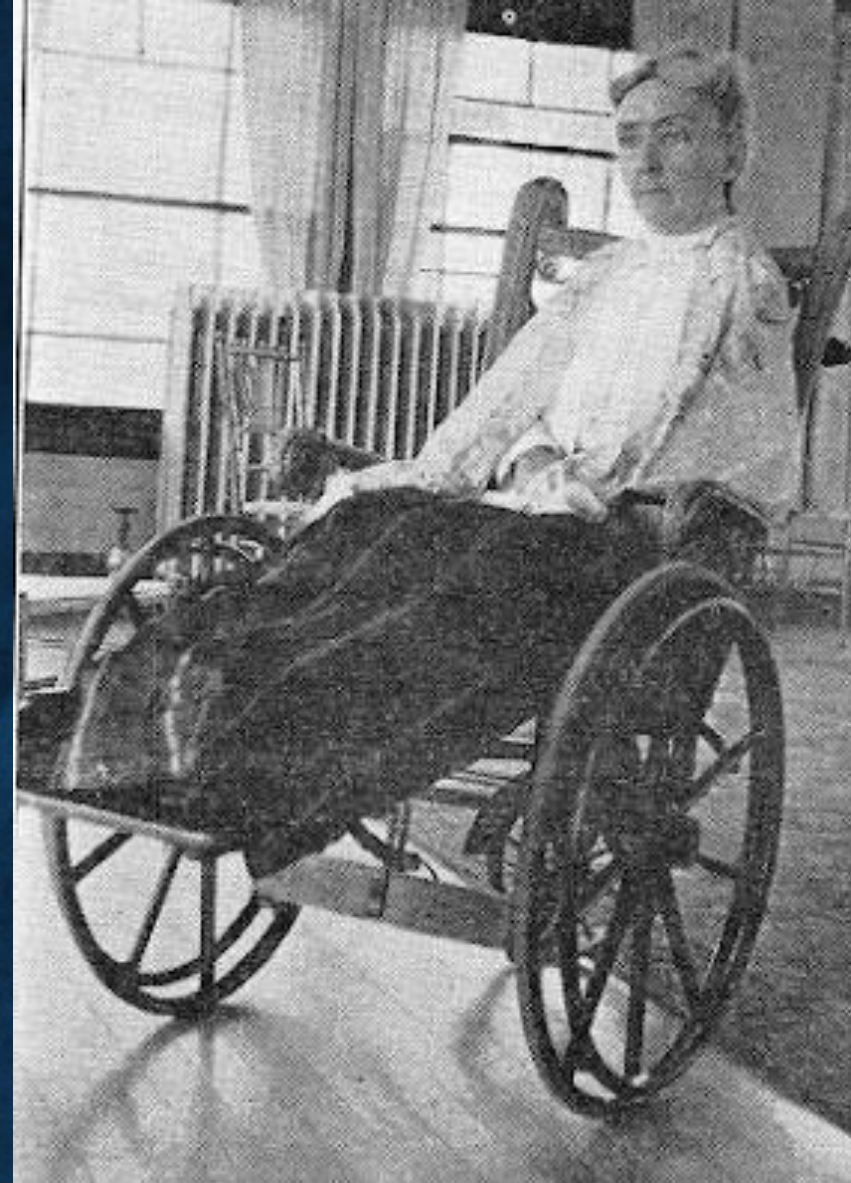

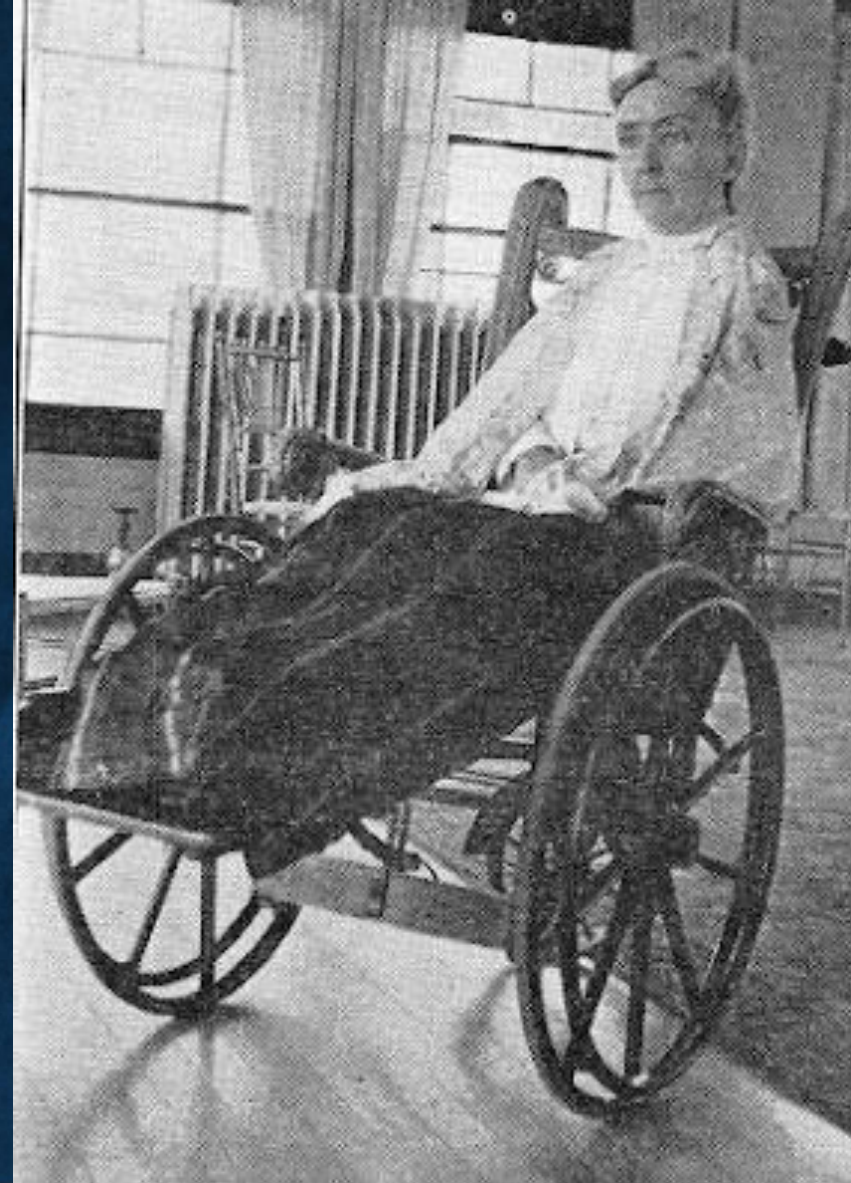
Some of us stay at the

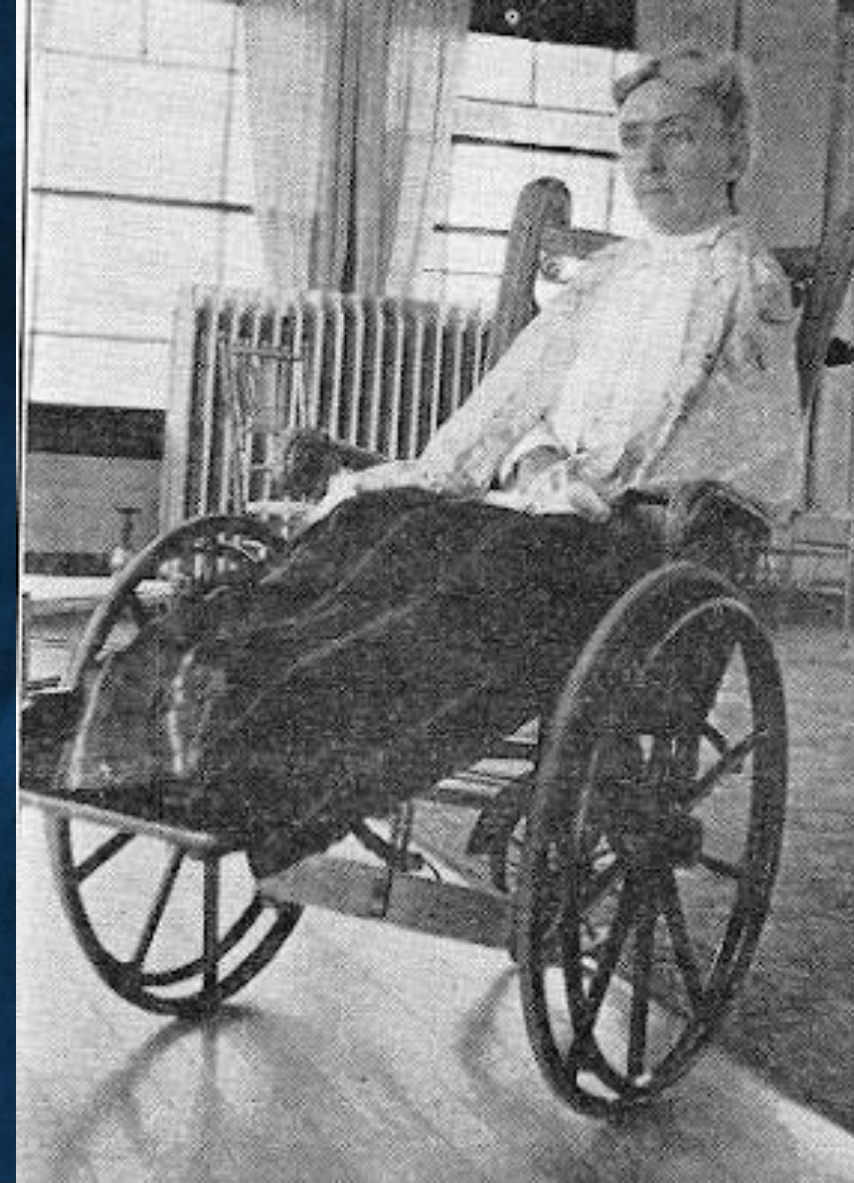

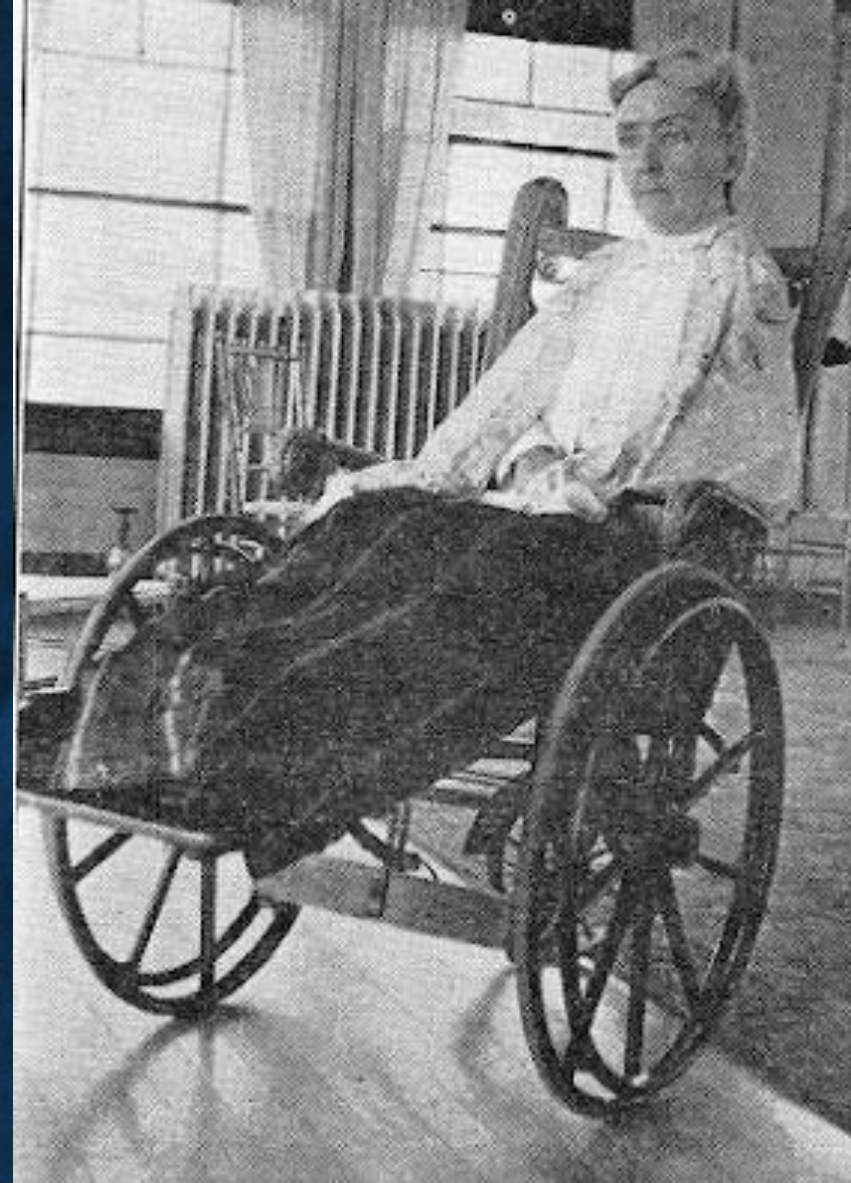
But the way of the cross never
