





"The Way of the Cross"


Some of us stay at the cross, some of us wait at the tomb, Quickened and raised with Christ, yet lingering still in the gloom.




"The Way of the Cross" Some of us 'bide at the Passover feast, with Pentecost all unknown, The triumphs of grace in the heavenly place that our Lord has made His own.



"The Way of the Cross" If the Christ who died had stopped at the cross, His work had been incomplete. If the Christ who was buried had stayed in the tomb, He had only known defeat,



"The Way of the Cross" But the way of the cross never stops at the cross and the way of the tomb leads on To victorious grace in the heavenly place where the risen Lord has gone."



¹⁴ And if Christ has not been raised, then our preaching is in vain and your faith is in vain. ¹⁵ We are even found to be misrepresenting God, because we testified about God that He raised Christ, whom He did not raise if it is true that the dead are not raised. **I** Corinthians 15:14-19
