

#### Taxes in The Bible

- 1. Under Joseph in Egypt (Gen 41:36-49; 47:26)
- 2. Under the Mosaic law (Exod 30:14; Lev 19:10)
  - about 24%
- Tithes, viewed as taxes
   (Lev 27:30; Num 18:21-24; Deut 14:29)
- 4. Under Nehemiah by the Persians (Neh 5:4-5)






#### Taxes in The Bible

- 9. Tribute tax (Matt 22:15-221 Mark 12:13-17)




