When We Should Resist The Government

- 1. When it orders you to violate Scripture (Acts 5:29-32)
- 2. When it orders you to be silent in the face of evil (Matt 14:1-2; 1 Kings 18:17-18)

Why Do We Need Law Enforcement?

- 1. Judgement is <u>Biblical</u> (Deut 19:21; Gen 9:6)
- 2. Judgement <u>Deters Crime</u> (Deut 13:11; 17:13; 19:20)
- 3. Judgement Can Lead to Pardon and/or Rehabilitation (Deut 25:3)





Examples of Law Enforcement in The Bible

- 1. Watchmen (Ezek 33:6)
- 2. Armed Guards (Neh 4:13)



KEY POINT:

There are consequences for resisting authorities



²⁵ "And you, Ezra, according to the wisdom of your God that is in your hand, appoint magistrates and judges who may judge all the people in the province Beyond the River, all such as know the laws of your God. And those who do not know them, you shall teach.
