

...these things stand behind the stability of civilized society, and they stand there necessarily, for God has declared it so, in harmony with reality, rather than with apostate sociological opinion.






Government, with its coercive powers, is a social necessity, but one determined by the Creator, not by the statistical tables of some university social research staff.




No society can successfully vote fines, imprisonment, corporal and capital punishment away permanently.



The society which tries has lost touch with realities of man (his fallen sinful state), realities of the world, and the truth of divine revelation in nature, man's conscience, and the Bible."


