# The Solution to the Divine Curse

Galatians 3:10-14

<sup>8</sup> The Scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, preached the gospel beforehand to Abraham, saying, “All the nations will be blessed in you.” <sup>9</sup> So then those who are of faith are blessed with Abraham, the believer.

<sup>10</sup> For as many as are of the works of the Law are under a curse; for it is written, “Cursed is everyone who does not abide by all things written in the book of the law, to perform them.” <sup>11</sup> Now that no one is justified by the Law before God is evident; for, “The righteous man shall live by faith.”

<sup>12</sup> However, the Law is not of faith; on the contrary, “He who practices them shall live by them.” <sup>13</sup> Christ redeemed us from the curse of the Law, having become a curse for us — for it is written, “Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree” —

<sup>14</sup> in order that in Christ Jesus the blessing of Abraham might come to the Gentiles, so that we would receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.

# Four Truths Regarding the Divine Curse

For whoever keeps the whole law and yet stumbles in one point, he has become guilty of all.

**James 2:10**

For when Gentiles who do not have the Law do instinctively the things of the Law, these, not having the Law, are a law to themselves, in that they show the work of the Law written in their hearts, their conscience bearing witness and their thoughts alternately accusing or else defending them,

**Romans 2:14-15**

Therefore the Law has become our tutor to lead us to Christ, so that we may be justified by faith.

and He Himself is the propitiation for our sins; and not for ours only, but also for those of the whole world.

**1 John 2:2**

and He Himself bore our sins in His body on the cross, so that we might die to sin and live to righteousness; for by His wounds you were healed.

**1 Peter 2:24**
